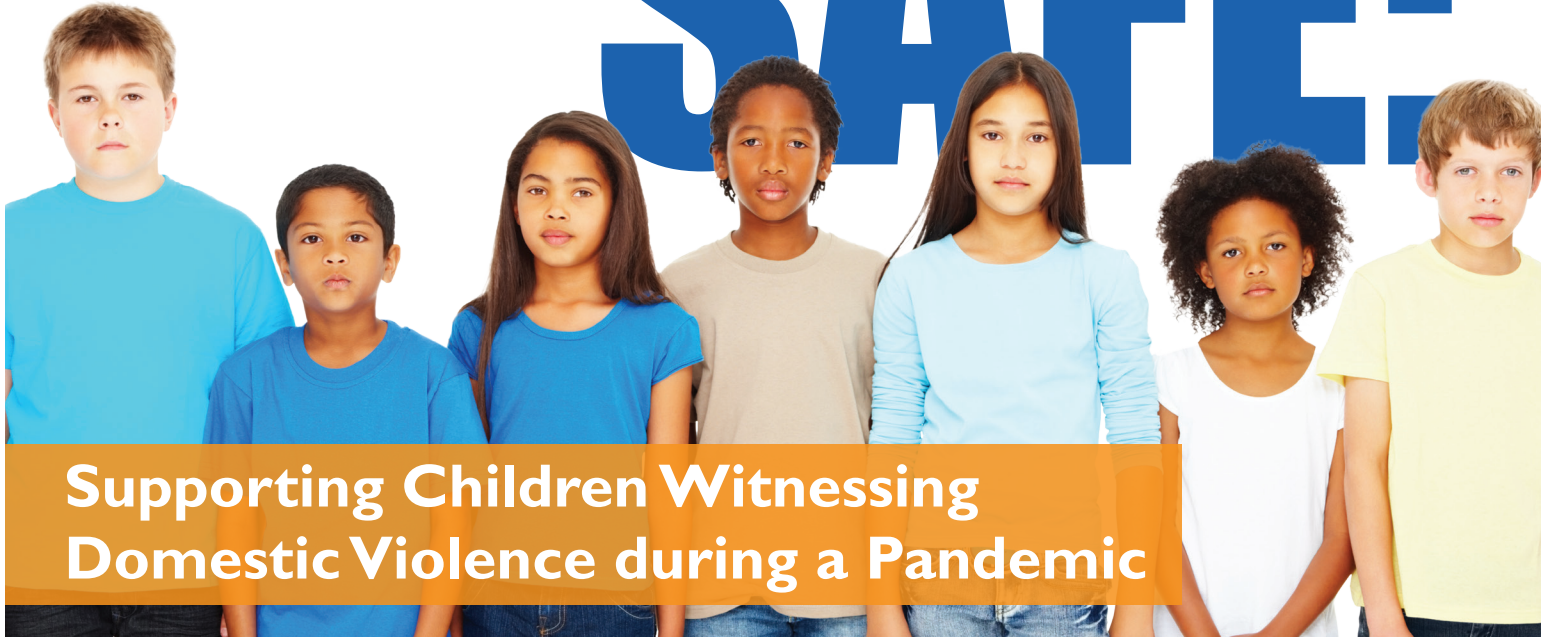


# When home isn't **SAFE.**



## Supporting Children Witnessing Domestic Violence during a Pandemic

What happens when existing support structures are cut off for children living in volatile family systems? Since the start of the pandemic, Safe+Sound Somerset has seen an over 35% increase in calls to their domestic violence hotline.

Now, more than ever before, we need to talk about the experiences of child witnesses to domestic abuse. We will review the impacts of witnessing domestic violence, define how children's support systems have changed as a result of COVID-19, and discuss ways to identify and reach out to children in crisis.
